<b>Course Information:</b>	A hot stone massage or Thermotherapy as its also known is a variation of the typical massages such as Swedish and Eastern with the added integration of hot stones. During the massage the therapist uses smooth, water-heated stones and sometimes in conjunction with cold stones, which are laid on specific points around the body. These then become part of the therapist's hands as she massages around the body. Localised heat produces vasodilatation and increases circulation of fluids in the area being focused on. The stones are smooth basalt rocks. They are formed after the eruption from volcanoes when the molten lava begins to cool and are usually fine-grained as a result of rapid cooling on the Earth's surface. As a result, these basalt stones retain heat very well.
